Entry requirements

In our market research we have found that many people are concerned about there not being any consistent standards about what constitutes a mentor. To be eligible to be nominated, they should have been mentoring for over ten years or made a significant contribution to the world of mentoring.

The International Register of Mentors

Over the years we have been contacted by organisations, mentors and individuals asking us to connect them with other mentors. We will therefore be publishing an online Register of Mentors available to the public, to connect with mentors or to help them check the status of their mentor. The Network will give each Mentor at Associate level and above a personal profile for them to edit. Each Mentor will have a unique profile URL that they can use to demonstrate their accreditation by an independent global mentoring organisation.

Sector Advisory Board

We will be holding elections from within the Network to a Sector Advisory Board. This is a Board (who will primarily meet online) of mentors from different sectors to provide advice, guidance and direction for the strategic aims of the network. Each sector will be represented by an elected mentor and an elected deputy.
