

# Why you should send your mentors to The Mentor Summit

## **What is The Mentor Summit?**

A conference for mentors and those involved in running mentor programmes. It originally began as an online conference to celebrate National Mentoring Day, but has now been extended into an in-person conference, which is also streamed online.

## **Who organises it?**

The conference is organised by Richard Daniel Curtis' team at The Mentoring School. They offer mentor training courses and are registering as an awarding body to convert them into official qualifications. They run a community for mentors and those interested in mentoring called the International Mentor Network.

## **Who is it aimed at?**

It is aimed at mentors, both employed and volunteers, plus those involved in running and administering mentoring programmes. We estimate the split to be about 70:30.

## **What will your mentors hear?**

Every Mentor Summit features mentors from different backgrounds sharing their stories. In addition we also mentees speaking about their experiences of mentoring. Often, there is also a presentation from someone involved in running a mentoring programme on the lessons they've learned.

## **What other activities are there?**

As we are a community-based organisation, we want people attending The Mentor Summit to meet other mentors. We therefore schedule in time outside of the coffee breaks for networking activities.
